Bring your kids to have fun playing games, coloring, decorating cookies, and participating in the Easter Egg hunt.

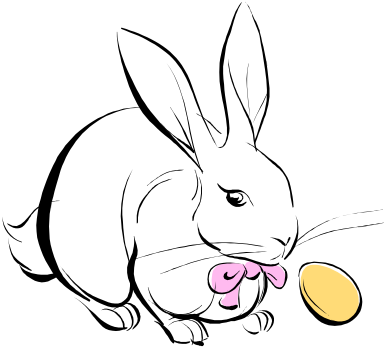
