Tip of the Month

Operation L.A.W. - Lakewood Auto Watch - decal program identifies a participating <u>Lakewood</u> resident's vehicle as being possibly stolen when it is on the road between the hours of 1-5 a.m. If a law enforcement officer sees your vehicle with the L.A.W. decal out during these hours, it gives them authorization to stop and investigate the vehicle's occupants. If you use your vehicle during these early morning hours, this program is not for you. But if you do not drive during the wee hours of the morning and would like to keep your vehicle safe, you can enroll at the Lakewood Sheriff's Community Safety Center or the Lakewood Sheriff's Station.
